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FOREWORD

Research-to-practice gaps have always existed and progress in this subject has been slow. Factors that contribute to this problem include lapses in communication between researchers and practitioners, and service delivery issues such as lack of public awareness, poor financing and a non-supportive political atmosphere. Scientific publications of research on intervention effectiveness, which do not provide information useful for widescale public health dissemination, also add to the problem (Ginexi & Hilton, 2020).

For strategic health science to have the intended impacts—improving public health practice, population health, and health equity—there needs to be a stronger pull from practice. The pull from practice can be enhanced by engaged and enlightened public health leaders who place a high priority on using evidence-based practices; encourage routine program evaluation, resulting in more practice-based evidence; support a culture of lifelong learning; and develop formal collaborations with academic institutions (Vaidya, Thota, & Proia, 2017).

On September 28th 2023, the Faculty Health of Science – Universitas Muhammadiyah Purwokerto, held the 3rd International Nursing and Health of Science activity with the topic of Bridging the gap: Linking EBP to Practice in Health Sciences with Innovative Interventions to Improve the Quality of Health Care.
